Net Generation of Subsidiary Power Plants Increased by 1.7%,
among which Subsidiary Wind Farms Increased by 9.2%,
Photovoltaic Plants Increased by 33.3%**

Total net generation of subsidiary power plants in March 2025 increased by 2.5% year on year to 17,028,099 MWh, among which, subsidiary wind farms increased by 7.1% year on year to 4,941,640 MWh, subsidiary photovoltaic plants increased by 14.1% year on year to 651,370 MWh.

Total net generation of subsidiary power plants for the first three months of 2025 increased by 1.7% year on year to 50,115,327 MWh, among which, subsidiary wind farms increased by 9.2% year on year to 12,997,391 MWh, subsidiary photovoltaic plants increased by 33.3% year on year to 1,731,373 MWh.
